**Description**

Jim Dalling, well known Queensland gamefish skipper and one of Australia's most successful, has a new seat...onboard the stunning new gamefisher Reel Chase, a purpose built game and sport fishing boat launched in March 2000. Jim was previously owner/skipper of ORCA with many tournament wins and world record fish captures.

A four cabin, galley-up layout, this big 55 footer is powered by twin 1135hp 12V92 Series III D-DEC's. In early sea trials the craft logged around 36 knots. It has a cruising speed in excess of 26 knots.

Fitted with the most modern electronics and fishing equipment, plus luxurious live aboard facilities, she will leave most other boats in her wake. Tankage is around 4,200lt and the craft is fully air-conditioned. Fishing equipment includes all brand new custom-built tackle, Lee's outriggers and Murray Brothers chair. A \$150,000 electronics suite is topped off by full-size scanning Wesmar sonar.

Together Jim and Reel Chase are an impressive combination giving anglers all they need to experience a truly successful and memorable fishing trip. Whether your dream is to tag a giant black marlin along the outer edges of the Great Barrier Reef off Cairns in North Queensland, tussle a yellowfin tuna off Port Stephens in New South Wales, or fish for coral trout for your dinner plate, your needs will be catered to.
