



Vessel Name: *Shaka*

Shaka is a hand-crafted 60ft sports fisher from legendary Australian boat builder, Assegai Marine. The hull is a cold-molded deep-V of western red cedar strip planked core encased in fibreglass and epoxy resin.

Powered by twin 1500 HP 10V2000M93 MTU engines employing the latest common rail technology, she has a top speed of 42 knots, a cruising speed of 32 knots and a range of 865 nautical miles at 20 knots.

Coupled to the engines are Twin Disc Quick Shift gearboxes allowing infinite slow troll speeds and fast response in fighting the hottest marlin. Shaka's fishing capability is further enhanced by a 96 mile/25kW radar, 3kW sounder and 360 degree sonar from Furuno and Wesmar coupled to a pc-based navigation system.

She is equipped with Rupp's outriggers, a Release Marine game chair, Shimano, Penn and Accurate reels and a full set of custom rods from light tackle 16lb to 130lb class.

Guest Facilities

Shaka's optimum guest complement is four, located in double and twin cabins (although there is some flexibility in this regard). Normal operation is with a crew of four.



The galley includes fridge/freezer capacity of 500lt (plus an ice-making machine) and contains everything necessary for the production of superb meals, from a five-hob induction cook top to a built-in espresso machine.

The saloon features retractable rear glass windows, generating a feeling of spaciousness and involvement in the cockpit action.

Onboard power is provided by two whisper quiet Onan gensets and air conditioning throughout ensures comfort on the hottest of summer days and nights.

Shaka has a PC-based entertainment system with a flat screen TV and Bose surround sound audio in the saloon, with separate TV/DVD systems in each of the guest cabins. The communications system includes local and satellite TV, internet and satellite phone.
