### Description

Built by world-renowned builder, Frank Woodnutt, and powered by continuously rated 500hp MTU. diesels, Viking II is considered one of the most practical and versatile sportfishing boats in Australia.

Her extra large cockpit is designed for handling Cairns' giant black marlin, while her saloon, galley and bar are all up on one level and open to the cockpit, delivering superior angler comfort and providing direct contact with all the fishing action. 2 air-conditioned cabins comfortably accommodate 4 anglers, and her power generating and water making facilities make extended liveaboard charters a comfortable option.

The boat is fully stocked with the latest technology in fish-finding and navigational electronics, and she offers medium, light and ultra-light tackle and saltwater fly fishing charters between Cairns (the Great Barrier Reef) and Port Stephens (near Sydney). Specialising in Giant Black Marlin on all tackle between Cairns and Lizard Island she also targets for Black, Blue and Striped Marlin, Sailfish, Giant Trevally, Spanish Mackerel and all Tuna species.
